


Firebird Timeslips Versions

Data Verification

Timeslips Administrator

Timeslips Firebird versions (2017, 2018, Premium and later) manage data verification differently than in the previous BDE versions. In any Firebird Timeslips version click the file menu and then data verification.

Balances

Rebuilding accounts receivable balances will remove bills for selected clients from all bill stages (Proof Stage, Revision Stage, and Audit Stage). This also prevents you from undoing approved bills for selected clients.

Note: This only affects clients that are actually repaired.

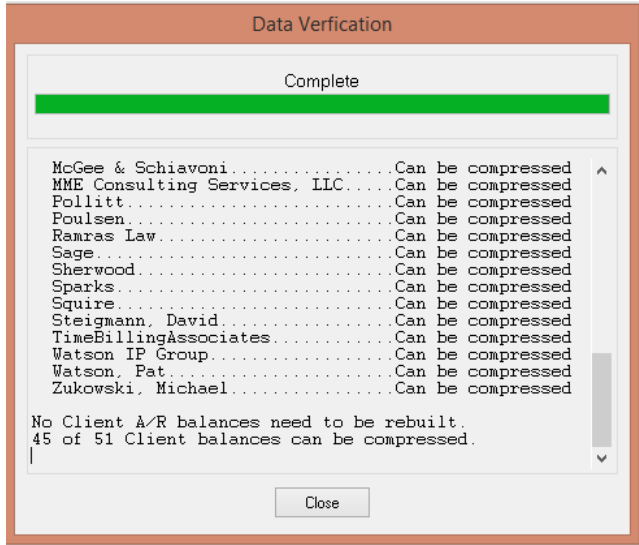

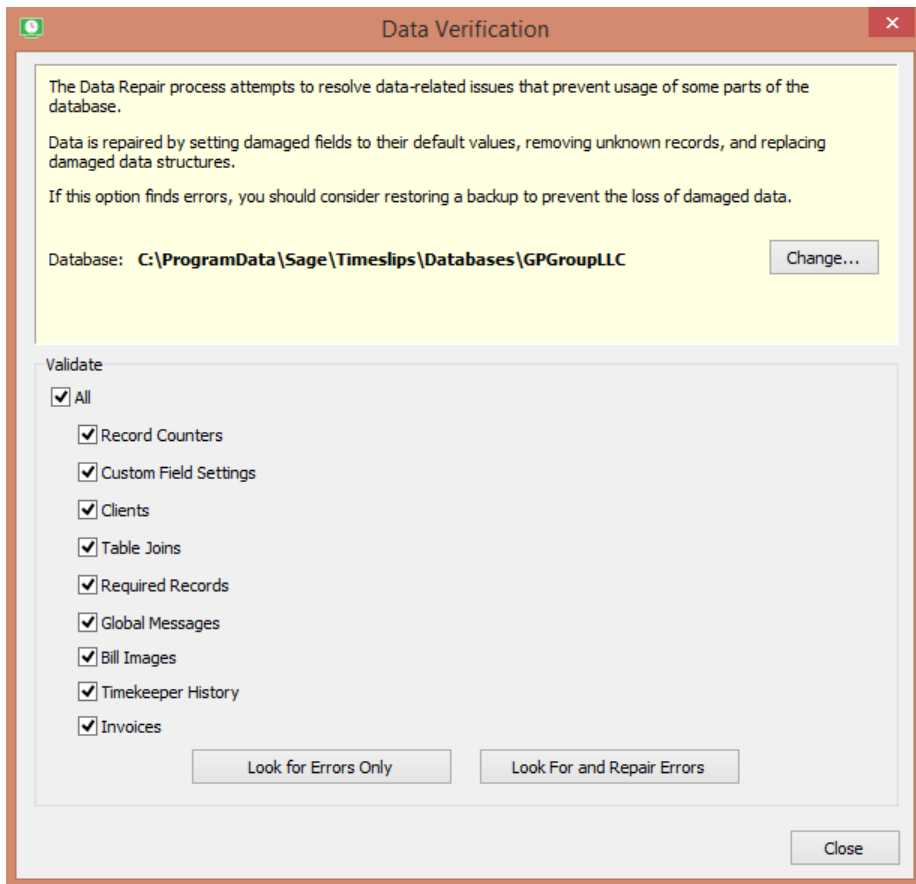
In the data verification dialog we can check and optionally repair accounts receivable and or funds balances for all clients in the database. We recommend looking for errors only as opposed to automatically repairing and errors found. Please ensure that you have a good backup in hand before proceeding.

Selecting “check accounts receivable balances for all clients and just looking for errors will produce the following screen and advise if client records need balances rebuilt.



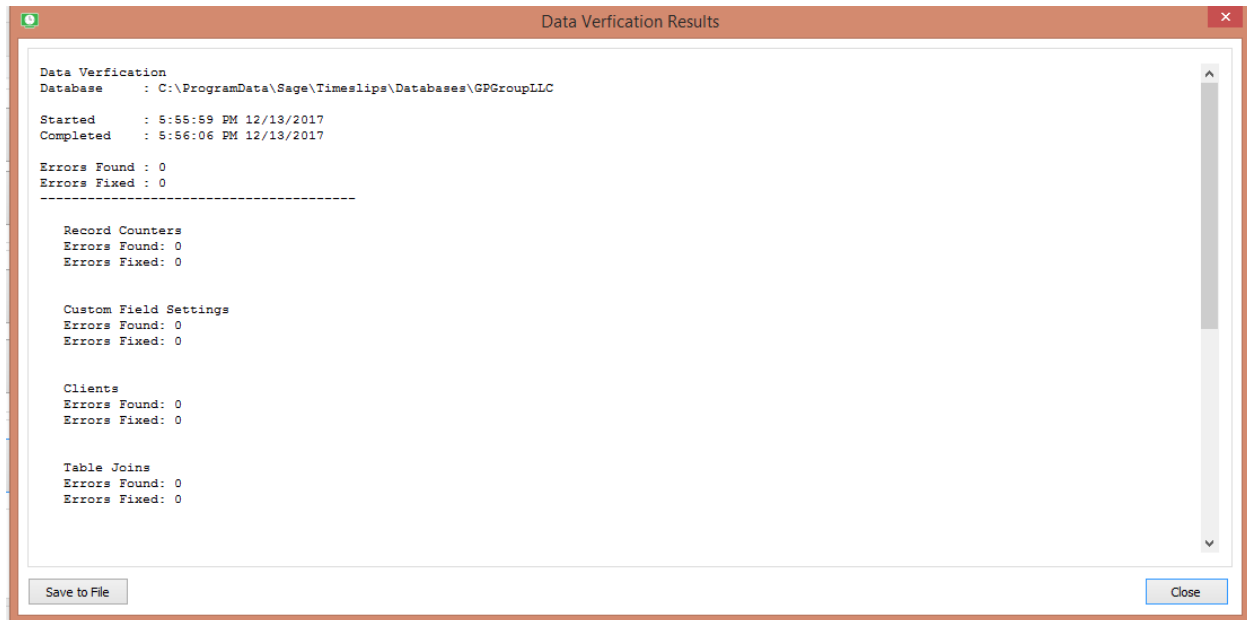
The list can be checked for any clients needing attention and a second pass can be made selecting just that client and repairing errors found. Client balances that can be compressed are completed when any balance is rebuilt.

In order to find and repair structural errors in your database click on the button in the data verification dialog "Run Timeslips Administrator".



In the data verification dialog, we can validate all areas of a Firebird Timeslips database and simply look for errors or look for and repair errors. As with balance rebuilds, we recommend looking for errors first and then executing repairs in a second pass after ensuring a good backup is in hand.

When complete the data verification results dialog appears with the ability to close or save to file. Please note that the time involved to complete the process is entirely dependent on the size of the database in question.



Once complete close the report and close out of Timeslips Administrator and back to the program itself.
